Instructions for Online live - streaming

The video of this service will be available shortly after the live-streaming service is over.

- Go to www.jonesvilleumc.org
- On the right-hand side at the top of the page, you will see "Quick Links".
 - If you are accessing via a smartphone, scroll all the way to the bottom to see the "Quick Links"
 - If you are accessing via a tablet, scroll all the way to the bottom to see the "Quick Links", or turn your tablet horizontal and "Quick Links" will be on the top right.
- This brought you to a new page on the www.jonesvilleumc.org website.
- Follow the instructions listed under JUMC Live Videos
 - Click on the "JUMC Live Videos" link
 - A new tab in your browser will open and you will be brought to the Jonesville Facebook page
 - You will see a list of videos published by JUMC
 - The top video will be the most recent church service. If you are accessing it on Sunday morning between 9:30 - 10:30, we will be live.
- Click on the video at the top of the list (top left if you are accessing via a computer) depending on the device you are using (laptop, tablet, or phone). It will have the most recent
 or current date.
- Remember that the video starts with pre-service announcements that change every 10 seconds. There is a timer to tell you how long until the service starts.

Look for an icon of an arrow pointing to the top/bottom corner and click on it to open the full screen.
